# THE JACK THE RIPPER TOUR MEETING POINT DIRECTIONS

THE TOUR DEPARTS FROM EXIT FOUR OF ALDGATE EAST AT 7PM SHARP
IT IS THEREFORE IMPERATIVE YOU ARRIVE AT 6.50PM

## THE MEETING POINT

The tour meets OUTSIDE EXIT FOUR OF ALDGATE EAST UNDERGROUND STATION.

When planning your journey please allow 3 minutes for every underground station you will pass through and then add 10 minutes to allow for any delays.

When you arrive at the station please do not just go out of the first exit you see as Aldgate East has exits at both ends of its platforms.

There are direction signs to the exits on the walls of both platforms so please take a few seconds to look for one of these and then follow the directions to EXIT FOUR.

Additional direction signs are also on the walls at the foot of each of the stairs from the platforms, so please just double check that you are going up the stairs that lead to EXIT FOUR of the station.

Once up the stairs, go through the ticket barrier and EXIT FOUR is the one on the right. It is signed EXIT FOUR. The tour meets at the top of the stairs on the pavement directly outside EXIT FOUR. You guide will be holding a "Jack the Ripper Tour" sign. Please ensure that you check in with your guide. Please do not simply join the first group you see, but check in first.

Please note due to staff holidays we will have no emergency phone coverage from 13th August to the 21st August 2017. It is, therefore, imperative that you arrive on time for the tours departure.

### ARRIVING BY ROAD

If you are arriving by road EXIT FOUR OF ALDGATE EAST UNDERGROUND STATION is located on WHITECHAPEL HIGH STREET.

EXIT FOUR is on the OPPOSITE SIDE OF THE HIGH STREET from the Whitechapel Gallery.

So simply make your way to the Whitechapel Gallery 77-82 Whitechapel High St, London E1 7QX. Whe you get there BE SURE TO CROSS TO THE OPPOSITE SIDE OF WHITECHAPEL HIGH STREET, and you will see EXIT FOUR. Please do not wait outside the Whitechapel Gallery, be sure to CROSS THE HIGH STREET to EXIT FOUR.

#### CATCH UP DIRECTIONS

Should you arrive late please follow these catch up directions. Again please do not ask directions of random strangers as they will not know where the tour goes.

On the opposite side of Whitechapel High Street you will see a pub called the White Hart. To its right, as you look at it, is an alleyway called Gunthorpe Street. The tour will be in this alley for around 10 minutes. The tour then goes to the opposite end of Gunthorpe Street, turns right along Wentworth Street, left along Brick Lane and pauses outside the Shaard Restaurant at the junction with Thrawl Street. It will be here for 5 minutes. The tour then continues along Brick Lane until it reaches Hanbury Street where it turns left. It will be somewhere on the right side of Hanbury Street for another 5 - 8 minutes. At the end of Hanbury Street, the tour turns left along Commercial Street and pauses outside Christchurch Spitalfields, the large white church on the left. This is over an hour into the tour.
